## 1. Granite Knolls Park – Solar Project

Darius Chafizadeh discussed Granite Knolls Proposed Solar Project with the Conservation Board. The Board Mr. Chafizadeh reviewed the mitigation for the project. The Board explained that Eastern Hemlock (Tsonga Canadensis) is highly susceptible to infestation by hemlock wooly algid, which can kill hemlocks in 4-10 years. They advised that a different native tree be planted, either another evergreen or deciduous tree that will provide screening and visual interest. The Board agreed that there should be an area dedicated for educational material to be viewed on solar energy and how it is being utilized at the park. Installation of EV chargers in the parking area were discussed and should be installed. SWPP for the runoff from the solar canopies onto the paved parking area, which will replace the gravel lot should be reviewed and approved by engineering.
