EXECUTIVE ORDER 203

- Signed June 12, 2020 by Governor Andrew Cuomo
- Requires all local governments with a police agency to perform a comprehensive review of current police force deployments, strategies, policies, procedures and practices.
- Also requires a plan to be developed to improve any deficiencies or shortfalls.

EXECUTIVE ORDER 203

- Each chief executive is tasked to convene a task force with:
 - Chief of Police
 - Community Stakeholders

EXECUTIVE ORDER 203

- The task force is to consult with:
- Members of the community
 - Non-profits
 - Faith-based community groups
 - Local office of the district attorney
 - Local public defenders



EXECUTIVE ORDER 203

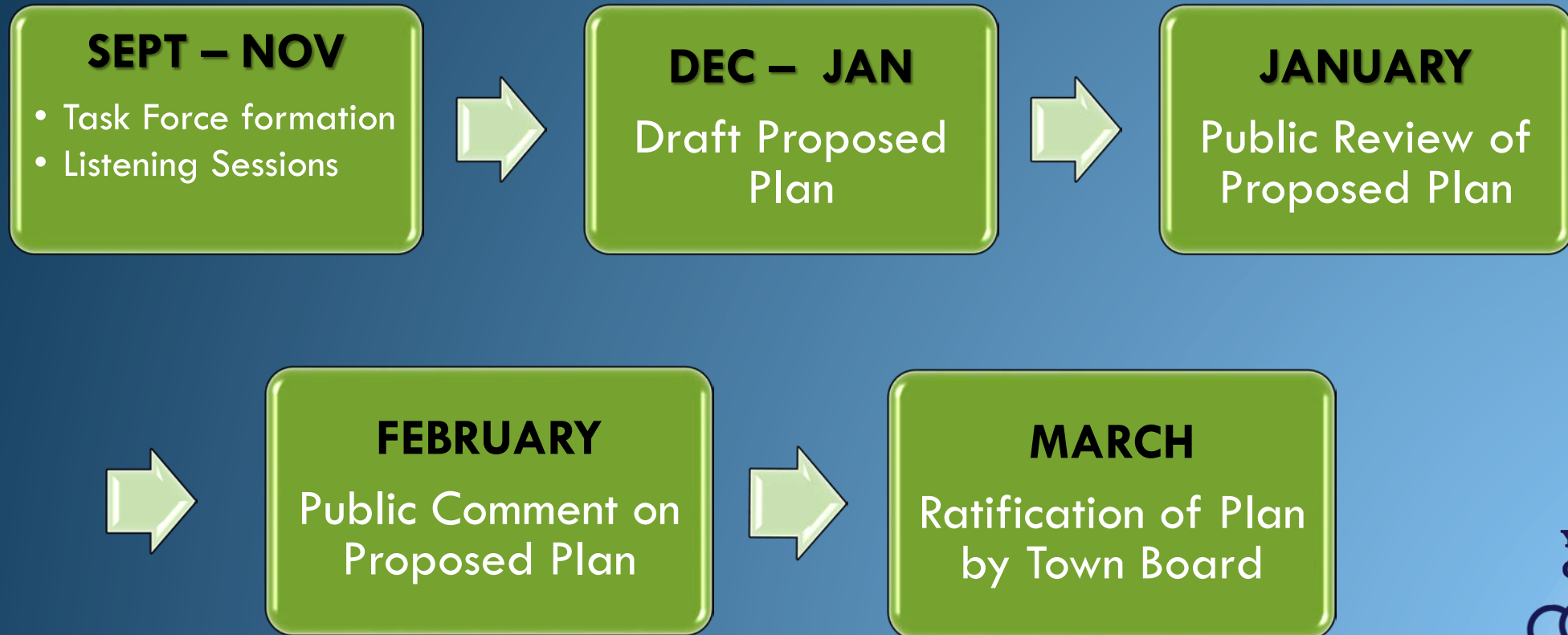
- Focus of task force is to review and evaluate:
 - Use of force policies
 - Implicit bias awareness training
 - De-escalation training and practices
 - Law enforcement assisted diversion programs
 - Restorative justice practices
 - Community-based outreach and conflict resolution

ESTABLISHING AN INCLUSIVE PROCESS

- Yorktown is required to transmit a report and a signed certification form to the Director of the Division of Budget by April 1, 2021.
- All meetings will take place virtually, be open to the public, aired on TV and streamed on the Town's website.
- Minutes will be recorded for all meetings, courtesy of the Town Clerk's Office, and included as part of the Town's final report.
- The focus of all discussions will be on the Town of Yorktown.
