In-Ground Pool Permit Instructions

To apply for an in-ground pool permit, please ensure the following documents and requirements are met:

1. Building Permit Application

- **Complete the Application**: Fill out the building permit application form, including homeowner and contractor information, cost of work, and square footage of the project.
- Signature: The application must be signed by the homeowner.
- Agent Filing: If an agent is submitting the application on behalf of the homeowner, a notarized Proxy Statement or Letter from the homeowner granting permission must be included.

2. Application Fee

• A non-refundable **\$125 application fee** is required. Please refer to the current fee schedule for any additional applicable fees.

3. Survey

- **Property Survey**: Submit a survey of the property that includes the following:
 - Location of existing structures.
 - Location and dimensions of the pool.
 - Setbacks from property lines, structures, or other pools.

4. Construction Plans

- **Detailed Plans**: Provide three (3) sets of detailed construction plans for the pool. These must be signed by an architect or engineer.
- **Pool Alarm Data**: Include a copy of the **pool alarm data sheet**.
- **Barrier Requirements**: Clearly demonstrate how the pool's **barrier requirements** will be addressed in the construction plans.

5. Contractor Insurance and Licensing

- **Proof of Insurance**: Provide a copy of the contractor's **Liability Insurance**, **Workers Compensation**, and **Disability Insurance**, with the **Town of Yorktown** listed as the certificate holder.
 - If the contractor is exempt from Workers Compensation or Disability, include the CE:200 exemption form.
- Westchester County Home Improvement License: Submit a copy of the contractor's Westchester County Home Improvement License.

6. Pool Equipment Specifications

• **Equipment Details**: Provide the specifications for all pool equipment (e.g., pumps, heaters) and specify the locations of these items on the survey.

7. Electrical Permit

• The Electrical Permit must be filed separately by a licensed Westchester County Electrician.

8. Storm Water Permit

• Storm Water Management: Contact the Engineering Department to file for the Storm Water Permit.

Important Notes:

- Incomplete applications or missing documents may delay processing.
- All documents should be submitted in **duplicate** where applicable.
