The 2016 Proposed Preliminary Budget totals \$56,521,034.00 representing a decrease of \$565,818.00 from the 2015 Adopted Budget with the following salaries of the elected officials:

Superintendent of Highways -	\$110,777
Town Justice (2) -	\$ 32,437
