A State of Emergency is hereby declared in the Town of Yorktown effective at 11:00 A.M. on Thursday, January 4, 2018.

The State of Emergency has been declared due to the impending snow storm / dangerous cold / high winds, and in conjunction with Governor Cuomo's declaration of a state of emergency.


This situation threatens the public safety.

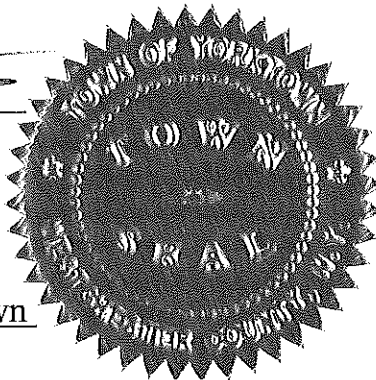
This State of Emergency will remain in effect until 8:00 AM on Friday, January 5, 2018.

As the Supervisor of the Town of Yorktown, I, Ilan Gilbert exercise the authority given me under section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being, and health of the citizens of the Town of Yorktown.

I hereby direct that all travel on the roadways in the Town of Yorktown is restricted to EMERGENCY VEHICLES, TOWN HIGHWAY VEHICLES, UTILITY VEHICLES, and essential emergency personnel. All unnecessary travel is prohibited

I further direct that all Town of Yorktown Departments and agencies take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property and provide whatever emergency assistance as necessary.
