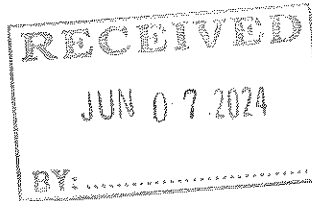

RE: 76 Route 6 Recycling Proposal

Dear Supervisor Lachterman,

Over the past few weeks many residents of the Yorktown community have contacted my office regarding the proposed recycling center at 76 Route 6 on the north side of Town. I am fully aware of the process by which town government assesses these proposals but I felt obligated to share some of the concerns that have been raised.

Impacted residents are concerned about the potential increase in traffic especially by oversized trucks that may be transporting material to and from the facility. Parents have raised safety concerns for their children waiting for their school bus as well as increased noise pollution from the industrial use of this proposed site.

I am confident the Town's departments and boards will properly examine this proposal and keep Yorktown's future in mind.
